- This is a team event.
- Open to CTTT 2025 league players.
Non-registered players can contact Sedick Abrahams for possible participation.
- Maximum of 15 teams will be allowed.
Team names shall not be Cape Town Table Tennis club names.
- Minimum 3 players and a maximum of 6 players per team.
No new players may be registered after Game Week 7.
- Team members do not have to be from the same club. **A maximum of 4 players from the same club will be allowed per team. No more than 2 players from the same club may play in any summer league week fixture.**
- 6 Match score card, with all matches on the scoresheet to be played till completion.
All matches will be best out of 3. Winning/Losing 2 games in a row = match over!
- There will be 2 fixtures every Monday and/or Wednesday night for the duration of the summer league, starting 7:30pm. Refer to playing schedule.
- Player 3 on the scorecard must play the doubles.
- Only one Premier/1st division player will be allowed per team. He/she will be Player 3. Premier league players will play with a -4 handicap only when playing any player from the 2nd league and below.
1st league players will play with a -3 handicap only when playing any player from the 2nd league and below. Any player that has represented South Africa at international level, will play with a -4 handicap.
Game sequencing will be as set out on the scoresheet.
- Team entry fee will be **R500.00** per team. The two teams playing in the final proper of the Summer League will gain free **team** entry to the next Summer League.
- Player registration fee **R100.00** per player.
- The fixtures draw will take place at Belthorn Community Hall on Monday 1st December, after which only the 1st round of games will commence.
- The top 4 league positions at the end of the summer league will proceed to the knockout semi-finals.
The winners and runners up will receive prize money.
League positions 5 till 8 shall proceed to the plate semi-final knockouts.
League positions 9 till 12 shall proceed to the loser's plate semi-final knockouts.
- Floating trophies will be presented to all finalists.

Table tennis balls and nets will be provided.
